### ARIZONA'S CHARTER MOVEMENT June 17, 1994

Governor Fife Symington signed into law House Bill 2002 — bringing charter school education to Arizona.

Arizona was the 11<sup>th</sup> state to allow charter schools

In the fall of 1994, 67 charter schools opened across the state.





#### 2015 AZMERIT


Charter students outperformed the state average of students passing the test in English Language Arts and Math by 5-12 percentage points in every grade level.
